

Local Rules

- 1) In the absence of Red lines or Stakes, the grass edge will define the margin of the hazard.
- 2) All shell cart paths are in play.
- 3) Non potable water is used for all golf irrigation.
- 4) Hole #7 – Ball drop area on green side of condition. If a ball is lost or unplayable inside the condition from the tee, please use the ball drop adding one penalty stroke.
- 5) Hole #8 – You may hit a second ball if you think your original ball has not cleared the red line defining the margin of the water hazard in front of the green and is not playable. In playing a second ball, utilize rule 26-1, relief for ball in hazard. Under penalty of one stroke, drop a second ball behind the water hazard, keeping the point at which the original ball FIRST crossed the margin of the water hazard directly between the hole and the spot on which the ball is to be dropped. If the original ball is found and playable the second ball is out of play.
- 6) Hole #10 – Ball drop on the other side of the lake (with penalty) for a ball in the water from the men's tee or a ball lost or unplayable along the Maintenance Building.
- 7) Hole #17 – Fence – The outside edge of the fence defines the margin of the lateral hazard. The Fence is an Immovable Obstruction. If it interferes with your stance or swing, determine the Nearest Point of Relief, no nearer to the hole and drop your ball one club length from that point. (Rule 24-2)
- 8) For any ball that enters a condition defined by red stakes with green tops and is lost, embedded or unplayable, reference the point where the ball crossed the margin of the condition, drop a ball within two club lengths of the point, no nearer the hole, and add one penalty stroke. Golf cars are not permitted inside staked areas. You may ground your club within the condition.
- 9) All sprinkler heads are Immovable Obstructions. If a ball lies off the green but not in a hazard and such an obstruction on or within 2 club lengths of the green and within 2 club lengths of the ball intervenes on the line of play between the ball and the hole the player may take relief as follows: The ball shall be lifted and dropped at the nearest point to where the ball lies (a) no nearer the hole, (b) avoids such intervention and (c) is not in a hazard or on a putting green. The ball may be cleaned when so lifted. (24-2).
