

LOCAL RULES

- 1) USGA Rules will govern play unless local rules are in effect.
- Laser measuring devices are permitted and must be shared.
- 3) White circles define Ground Under Repair.
- 4) In the absence of Red lines or Stakes, the grass edge will define the margin of the Hazard. All bulkheads within penalty areas are integral parts of the course, there is no free relief.
- 5) All shell cart paths are in play.
- 6) Relief may be given for an embedded ball in the "General Area" (except in
- 7) Hole #8 You may hit a second ball if you think your original ball has not cleared the red line defining the margin of the water hazard in front of the green and is not playable. In playing a second ball, utilize Rule 17-1, relief for ball in hazard. Under Penalty of one stroke, drop a second ball behind the water hazard, keeping the point at which the original ball FIRST crossed the margin of the water hazard directly between the hole and the spot on which the ball is to be dropped. If the original ball is found and playable the second ball is out of
- 8) Hole #17 Fence The outside edge of the fence defines the margin of Out of Bounds, Objects defining out of bounds such as walls, fences, stakes and railings are not obstructions and are deemed to be fixed (Definitions: Out of Bounds). If it interferes with your stance or swing, the player may play the ball as it lies or under penalty of one stroke proceed under Rule 19 for Ball Unplayable.
- 9) For any ball that enters a condition defined by red stakes and is lost. embedded or unplayable, utilize Rule 17-1, relief for ball in hazard.
- 10) All sprinkler heads are immovable obstructions. If a ball lies off the green, but not in a hazard and such an obstruction on or within 2 club lengths of the green and within 2 club lengths of the ball intervenes on the line of play between the ball and the hole, the player may take relief as follows: The ball shall be lifted and dropped at the negrest point to where the ball lies (a) no negrer the hole. (b) avoids such intervention and (c) is not in a hazard or on a putting green. The ball may be cleaned when so lifted. (16-1).


